homework

Students should read 20-30 minutes every night. No reading logs will be collected, but students will be utilizing the AR program this year.

Most work will be able to be completed in class if students use their time wisely. If work is assigned, this will **ALWAYS** be written down in his or her planner and posted online.

If students do not complete work during class, in the time allotted, it will be assigned as homework so students can adhere to the determined deadlines.



Absences and Late Work

Weekly and daily work will be updated weekly on Fridays. Please check grades regularly and feel free to ask me any questions that you might have about a particular grade.

If you are absent, you are responsible for completing your make-up work.

Missing work can be turned in until the given deadline and will receive a grade of 50% until turned in and graded.
